Dear Cass School District 63 Parents,

As long and hard as this past year has been, we are quickly rounding the corner to a new year! Every year has its challenges, but 2020 is one for the books on so many levels. Personally, I will always remember 2020 for many things, but one of the greatest blessings is getting to serve this wonderful school community as the superintendent. Reminder – Remote Instruction Through January 15th

As a reminder and as announced previously, the week of December 14th, immediately prior to the winter break, will be full remote instruction for all students. Our teachers will follow the same daily schedule from Monday, December 14th through Thursday, December 17th as they normally would any other week. As a reminder, the Friday, December 18th School Improvement Day is an independent learning day without live instruction. Independent learning activities are assigned in advance for all School Improvement Days. Please email your child's teacher if you have any questions at all.

We are also planning for full remote instruction for the two weeks after the winter holiday break. With a teacher institute day already planned for Monday, January 4th, we will resume with the full remote daily schedule Tuesday through Friday of that week. We will then follow the remote schedule for just one more week from January 11th through the 15th.

Return to Blended In-Person Instruction January 19th

We will resume the blended in-person instruction schedule on Tuesday, January 19th, immediately after the Martin Luther King Holiday. The rationale for these changes have been explained previously, but it is important because we want to mitigate any health risks around and after the holidays so that we can sustain in-person learning in a healthy and responsible manner once we return on Tuesday, January 19th.
