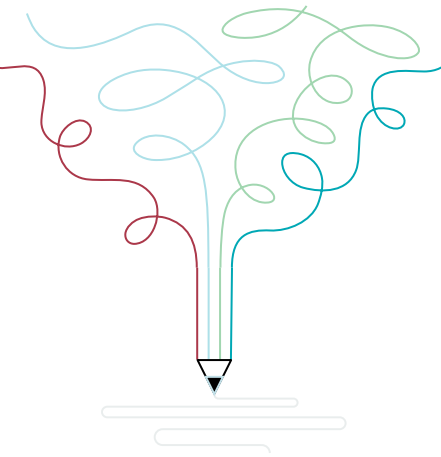
WRITING COMPETITION
